SAN FRANCISCO TROLLEY DANCES (SFTD)

is a two-day, free (with MUNI fare) public performance curated by Epiphany Dance Theater Artistic Director Kim Epifano. Through collaborations with artists and ensembles at specific sites along San Francisco's MUNI routes. Each group is invited to create a 8-10 minute piece in response to the physical environment, architecture, and history of the area!

CALIFORNIA DANCE STANDARD INCLUDED IN KOT WORKSHOP:

3RD GRADE

Improvise and select possibilites to solve a movement problem

4TH GRADE

Create a dance study that has a beginning, a middle, and an end

5TH GRADE

Demonstrate principles of opposing weight and force/energy, balance and counterbalance

6TH-8TH GRADE

Collaborate with others in preparing a dance presentation for an audience

9TH-12TH GRADE

Demonstrate originality in using partner or group relationships to define spatial patterns and use of space

COLLEGE LEVEL

Supporting individuals artistic choices to express thought, choreography, and research to further develop creative and critical thinking

Epiphany's SFTD program is 2 parts:

KOT Workshop, and Friday SFTD performance!





PART 1: YOUR ONLINE WORKSHOP

Taught by Epiphany's Teaching Artists, participants are introduced to the concept and creation of Site Specific Dance. Each workshop follows this basic format:

- View the previous year's SFTD video for background of the event
- Interactive discussion about the featured artists, their diverse movement styles, and the history of the SF performance sites and neighborhoods
- Students move in their own space to create sitespecific dance following a simple score lead by KOT Teaching Artist
- students will create, memorize and perform a dance using different shapes, architecture, environment, forms of locomotion, and voice.
